The regular monthly meeting of the Community Schools Advisory Board was held on Wednesday, February 10, 2016 in the Yellow IRC at Brockton High School. Winique Green called the meeting to order at 7:07 PM. A quorum was present and the following matters were discussed.

**WELCOME** Winique Green asked those in attendance if they had reviewed the minutes of the meeting held on January 13, 2016.

**ACCEPTANCE OF JANUARY 13, 2016 CSAB MINUTES** IT WAS MOVED BY JAMES COBBS AND SECONDED BY SHEILA MULLANEY ACCEPT THE MINUTES OF THE JANUARY 13, 2016 MEETING.

**ORGAINAZATION OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE** Heather Arrighi welcomed Winique Green as the new Chair. Heather discussed the responsibilities of the Executive Committee. Sheila Mullaney nominated herself as an At Large representative. Joe Moses made a motion to appoint Sheila Mullaney to the Executive Committee and the nomination was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dr. Cobbs. Shaynah Barnes asked if a member of the Board could still submit a nomination for a Baroncelli Award. Still need a General Member nomination. Tabled discussion until the next meeting.

**REVIEW OF BYLAWS** Heather Arrighi asked if everyone had reviewed the bylaws to see if any updates were needed. Winique Green asked if a Finance and Oversight Committee exists. Heather Arrighi said the language can be added if a need arose for fund raising. Shaynah Barnes asked that the bylaws be sent out electronically again a week before the meeting and then an email to remind everyone 3 days before the meeting that the bylaws will be discussed. Tabled discussion until next month.

**ADULT LEARNING CENTER** Heather Arrighi explained Kathleen Quinn's absence.

**PROGRAM UPDATES** Spring programs currently enrolling- ESL, Yoga, SNAP. New this spring, Community Schools is also offering a "Mommy and Me" paint night, and it was asked if more than one child could attend.

Heather Arrighi attended several sites to observe Community Schools Basketball program which is currently running at the George, West and East Middle Schools. All Stars and Coach Classic will be coming up soon. It was asked if we could charge admission to these games to perhaps generate some revenue.

**BARONCELLI AWARD** Heather Arrighi explained the history of this award. Information and forms will be sent to schools, afterschool programs and city officials regarding nominations. Voting will take place by the Executive Committee of the Board prior to the May 11, 2016 CSAB meeting.

**NEWS FROM THE SCHOOLS** Brett Gormley asked about having fee based programs in the Middle Schools as an alternative to Extended Day. Joe Moses suggested a survey to the teachers and parents to see what programs the parents would like to participate in and what programs the teachers would like to teach.

Melisa Castelo suggested that it could be done as a civics lesson and have the School Committee member in each ward conduct a “vote” at each of the schools in their ward as to what the students would be interested in.

**EXTENDED DAY** The Extended Day program will be held at the Arnone site again this year, according to Mike Thomas.
