#### Do you want to improve your English skills quickly?

Then Intensive English is for you!

Class time is spent learning and practicing English skills from listening and speaking to reading, writing, and grammar.

You will study English with others who have similar English language abilities. You and your teacher will be speaking, reading, and writing in English.

#### Term schedule

Classes are five hours per day, four days per week. Terms are seven weeks long. This translates to 140 hours of in-class learning per term.

Classes are offered Spring T1, T2, Summer T1, T2, Fall T1, T2

Weekend Study is also available each term. These classes will have extremely limited spots available, and will only be offered in one level. Students enrolled in the weekend classes only complete 84 hours of in-class study and **are not** eligible for advancement to the next level of English.

# Basic Language Literacy (BLL) and Basic ESL (BESL)
